Chaplain's Message

With the Sacred Triduum we celebrate the most important truth of our salvation -- the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Every time we make our personal profession of faith to God we tell Him that we believe in all that the Holy

Roman Catholic Church teaches. We believe that in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus is contained, offered and received, under the appearance of bread and wine. (What follows is a mere summary -- almost verbatim -- of the catechismal teaching.)

“The Eucharist is the very sacrifice of the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus.” Jesus continues to offer his Body and Blood for our sake thru the centuries till his return in glory. The Eucharist is the banquet and living memorial of Christ’s sacrifice. By partaking in the Risen Christ (worthily, i.e., according to the rules of the church) we participate even now in God’s own life. In accord with our Lord’s command at the Last Supper every priest thru the Mass re-presents the death and resurrection of Christ; so, the Eucharist contains the entire spiritual wealth of the Church, bringing all into a sacred communion with the Most Blessed Trinity and with one another.

We owe God this thanksgiving. We bring its power into our daily lives. Together with the angels and saints we serve God in this “heavenly liturgy.”

Jesus make his presence present in this sacrifice of love, this great mystery of our faith.
